Where do I come from?


I was born in Halmstad, but raised in Helsingborg.

In my opinion, one of the most beautiful city in all of Sweden.








Helsingborg

We do not have school sports. All sports are played in private clubs.


Me and my friends

I'm a person who hangs out very often with girls, and people have the impression that I'm a **ladies man**.




My friends from Maria Carrillo HS



The days when it went up to 115°F


An earthquake
