NATIONAL CRISIS The Center for Disease Control and Prevention is warning of an accelerating mental health crisis among adolescents, with more than 4 in 10 teens reporting that they feel "persistently sad or hopeless," and 1 in 5 saying they have contemplated suicide, according to the results of a survey published March 2022.



LOCAL CRISIS:

According to the "YouthTruth" survey conducted by Community Foundation Sonoma County, when asked if they feel like a real part of their school's community, only 34% of Sonoma County high school students say yes. More than one in every 10 of these same students say they have considered suicide in the last 12 months.

According to A Portrait of Sonoma County 2021, **Sonoma County** has the second highest youth suicide rate out of the nine Bay Area Counties.
