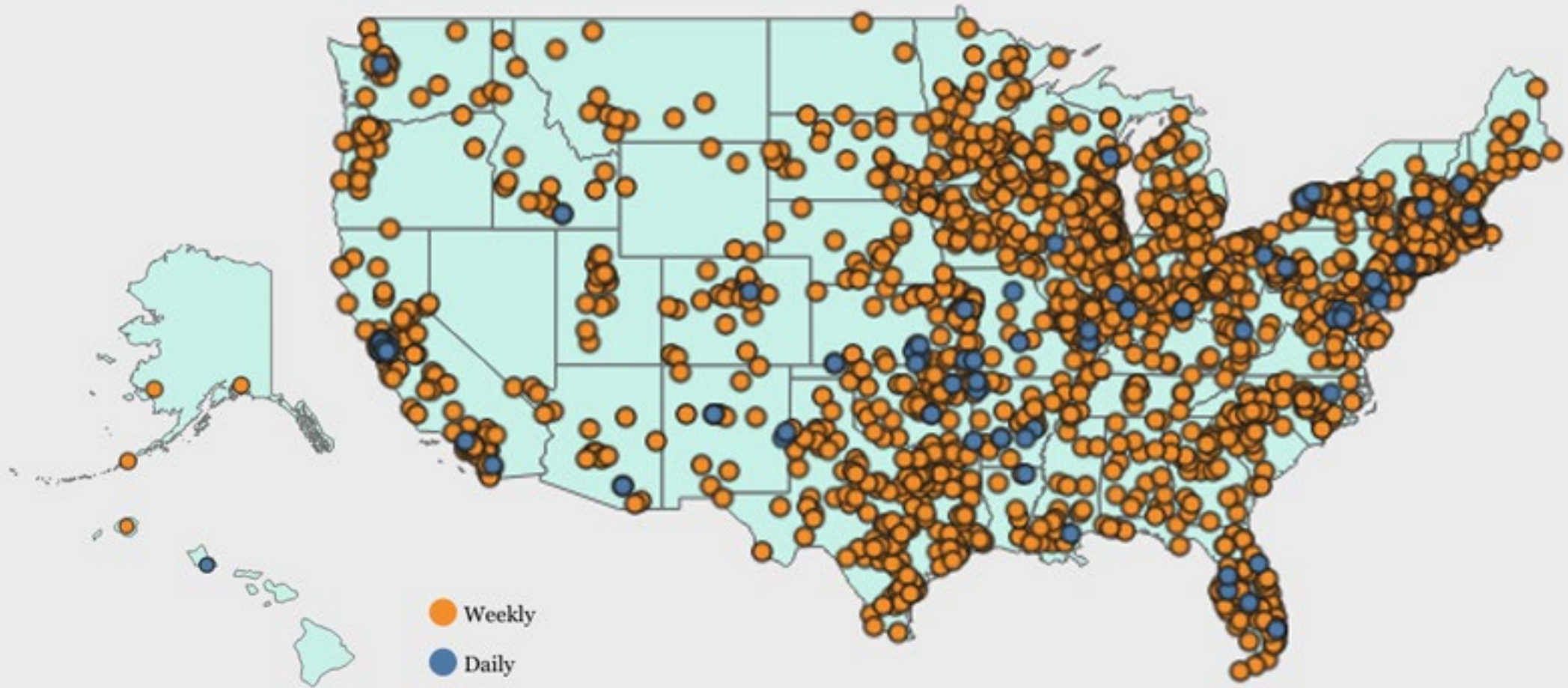

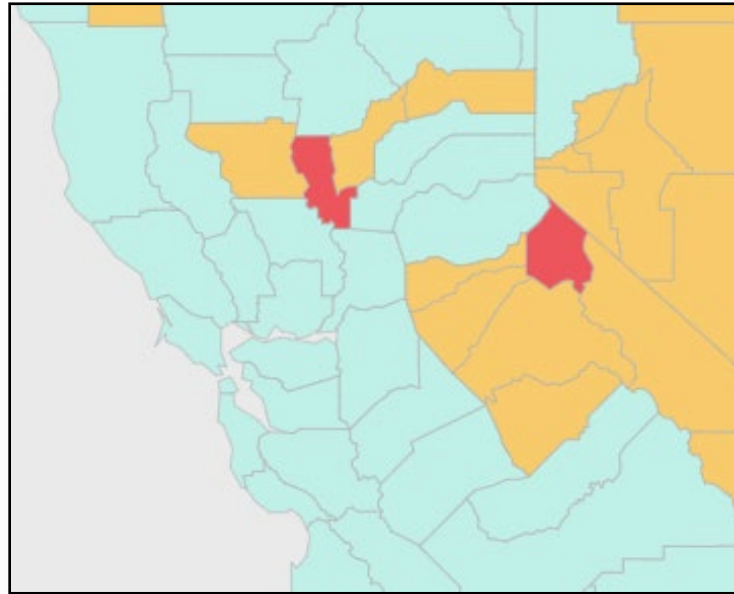
WHERE HAVE NEWSPAPERS DISAPPEARED?

Since 2004, the U.S. has lost more than 2,100 newspapers.



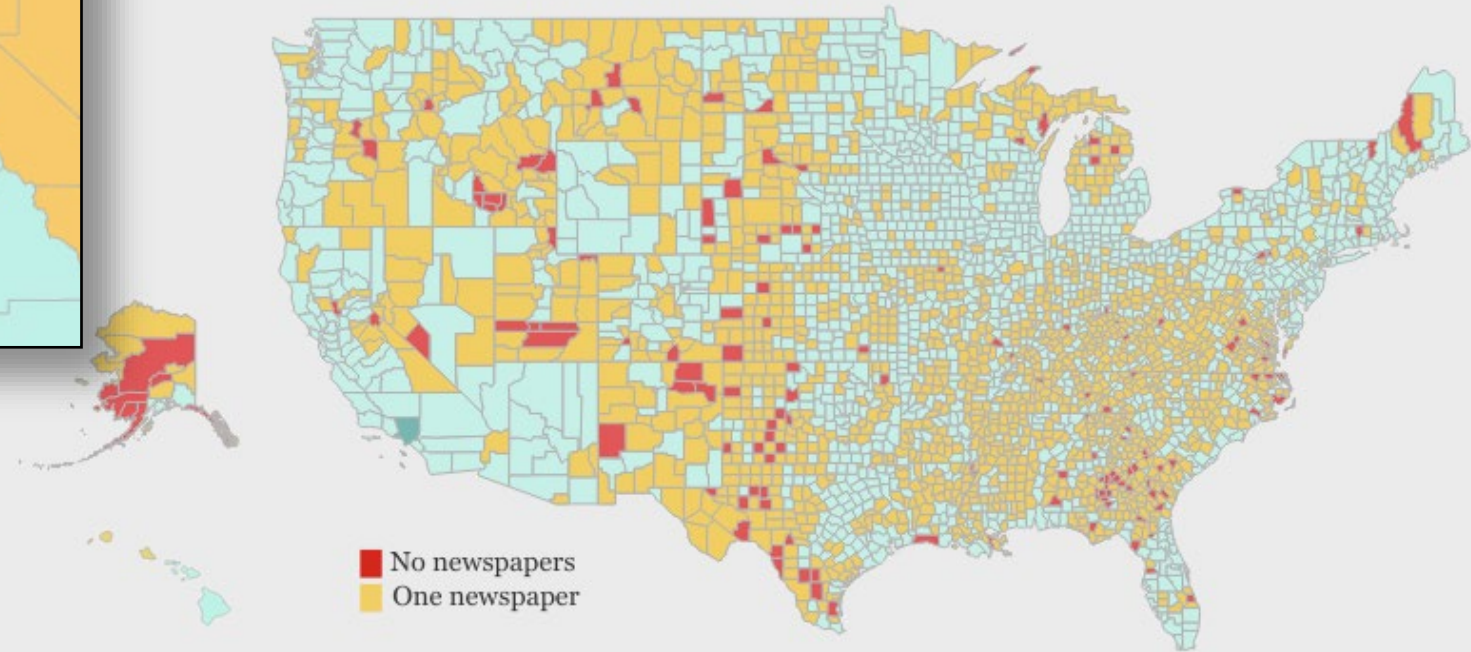
